About Photographic Images and Matter: Japanese Prints of the 1970s:

Discover the groundbreaking era of the 1970s Japanese contemporary art in this year's traveling exhibition: Photographic Images and Matter: Japanese Prints of the 1970s. Featuring works from 14 influential artists, witness the birth of a new print movement where materials like print blocks, paper, and ink take center stage, shaping contemporary art trends. The exhibition is divided into two sections: "The Age of Photographic Images" which explores the integration of photography into printmaking, and "Images of Autonomous Matter" which showcases works driven by the expressive power of matter itself.

Passport DC is an annual celebration of international culture presented by Events DC which showcases Washington DC's embassies and cultural organizations with tours of more than 70 embassies and hundreds of events.
