ABOUT THE PERFORMERS



Fujiki Daichi is one of Japan's highest-profile international artists and has made a brilliant debut at the hallowed institution of opera, the **Vienna State Opera**, and is expected to continue his activities as a front-runner in the world of classical music. He regularly gives recitals throughout the country performing a diverse repertoire from baroque to contemporary, as well as appearing in the media as a performer and specialist. He also is a guest professor at **Senzoku Gakuen College of Music**.



Inoi Ami has been recognized at an early age in Japanese youth competitions. Amongst her early achievements are the 1st prize at the **35th Guitar Music Grand Prix** (2010, Osaka) at the age of sixteen and 3rd prize at the **2014 Taiwan International Guitar Competition** in Taipei. Her most recent and prestigious success came in 2022, when Inoi was selected as the first Japanese artist to reach the finalist stage at the **Guitar Foundation of America International Competition** in Indianapolis, the most sought-after classical guitar competition in the world.
