After spending 30 years in a loveless marriage, a workaholic husband decides to leave his wife for a younger woman. Another couple is reminded of their affection for one another when a serious health issue interrupts their constant quarreling. And a woman who has been far more successful in her career than in love connects with a widower who thinks he has nothing to offer. Inspired by 86,441 actual love letters submitted to the “Love Letters at 60” project in Japan, *Dear My Love* intricately intertwines the past, present and future of three older Tokyo couples as they take a second chance at love.

Too shy to voice their appreciation and too busy to show they care, the “Love Letters at 60” project encouraged long-married couples to express the love and appreciation they felt for their partners but could not say in words by writing them on a single postcard. Based on the sincere emotions conveyed through these love letters, this moving film will instill courage and hope in everyone wishing to live life to the fullest.
