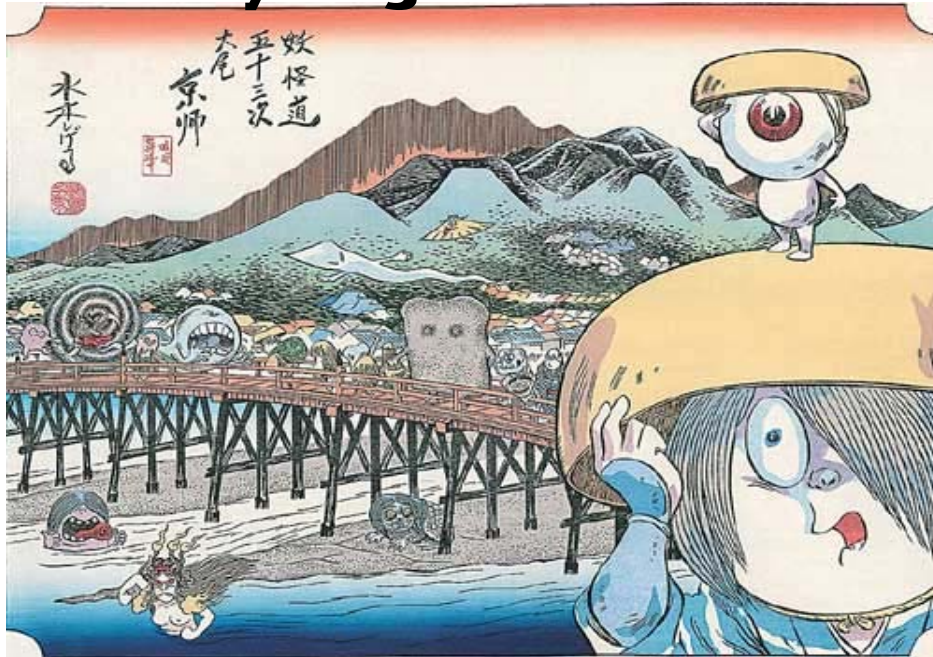


# Fifty-Three Stations of the Yokaido Road

A Haunted Journey Down a Classic Ukiyo-e,

Shigeru Mizuki, venerated as one of the fathers of manga or Japanese comic books, has recreated the classic *Fifty-Three Stations of the Tokaido Road Ukiyo-e* series by Hiroshige Utagawa. Mizuki's *Fifty-Three Stations of the Yokaido Road* incorporates characters from his *GeGeGe no Kitaro* manga.

The *Kitaro* series has run for almost 50 years, first in comic books and later in television programs, video games, and animation movies. A live action, feature-length movie was released in April 2007. *GeGeGe no Kitaro* features many traditional *Yokai* (spirits) from Japanese folklore.
