Shot on a modest budget over just eight days, One Cut of the Dead was never expected to achieve the massive success it did. Premiering on only two screens in Tokyo, the film quickly garnered international attention, leading to a wider release and critical acclaim. Ultimately, it became one of the highest-grossing films of 2018. The movie kicks off with an impressive 37-minute one-take sequence during what seems like a standard zombie film shoot—until things take an unexpected turn.

*One Cut of the Dead* is not just a zombie film but a story of indie filmmakers and the spirit and passion that goes into making independent films. Elizabeth Kerr of *The Hollywood Reporter* praised it as "a breezy and often laugh-out-loud hilarious zombie comedy."
